In the name of God Amen I Nathaniel Armistead of the County of Alleghany and State of Virginia, being old & infirm and aware of the uncertainty of life, being known in the full enjoyment of a sound mind and disposing memory, do make this as my last will and testament, hereby revoking all other wills heretofore made by me.

Item - I will all my beds, bedding and furniture as well as all other household & kitchen furniture I may be possessed of, to my three Children, George J. Armistead, William L. and Martha J. Armistead, to be equally divided between them.

Item - I will and bequeath one hundred dollars to each of my Children viz, John, Joel, David, James, George S, & William J. Armistead, Polly Miller, Malin & William and Martha J. Armistead, to be paid to them by my Executors

Item - I will and bequeath to my grandchild George J. Nicholson, son of my deceased daughter Delila Nicholson one hundred dollars, which is to be paid to him at interest after my death, and paid to the said George J. Nicholson as soon as he shall attain the age of twenty one years, provided he will then agree to live
