Leany, Samuel Carpenter, Joseph Cammon, Christopher Cammon & Charles Callaghan, his executors, entered into & acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Twenty four thousand dollars Conditioned as the law directs. Certificate is granted the said Andrew Cammon for obtaining letters of Administration on the estate of the said deceased estate with his will aforesaid annexed in due form.
