I give to my daughter Fannille Emaline Carter my Negro boy, Buster to her and her children forever. I also hereby ratify the donation of land, cow &c. heretofore made her.

13th

I give to my daughter Mary M. Carter, to her & her children my Negro boy Jack and hereby ratify donation of personal property heretofore made her.

14th

It is my will & desire that the balance of my personal property of all kinds and descriptions, shall be sold by my executor, and after the payment of debts funeral expenses & costs of administration the net proceeds thereof shall be equally divided between my wife and all my children, my wife to have a child's part.

I hereby appoint and appoint my friends Andrew Ramm and my son Michael J. Smith executors of this my last will.
