In the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty six I being of the age of years and being of sound memory and mind, but knowing that it is appointed unto all men to die, I make this my last will and testament in the first place I will and bequeath my soul to God who gave it, and my body to be buried a Christian like manner, and my worldly goods in the following manner, In the first place I will to my wife Mary E. Master my entire estate, both real and personal, during her natural life time, and at her death, I will my estate to be equally divided between Joseph Jackson, John E. Green and William A. Master. I will that during my wife's life time, that she is not to be held accountable for the natural and necessary wear of my estate or death of stock, caused by lapse of time - and all provisions grain and meat is to be regarded as necessary for my wife's use and not to be accounted for at her death, and lastly I appoint my wife Mary E. Master as my executrix, and I do not require her to give bond and security for the administration of my estate.
