 and sound memory and coming to mind
 that all flesh must give to death when it
 shall please god to call them out of this
 world I make and ordain this my last will
 and Testament in manner & form as follows
 viz I do give my Body to be buried in
 a pious Christian manner and my funeral
 charges first paid and all my just Debts

George Waid of my own free will and full Power
 personal I give and bequeath to my beloved wife
 Mary during her natural life to keep up my
 three Daughters Sarah Meriah and Elizabeth
 in & give them Education and at her death
 the whole of my Estate to be equally divided
 between my said three Daughters. It is my
 will that my wife see my Dearest child
 Meriah and with the money of such Sale
 she purchase another young man or girl with
 the increase if there be any he also divided
 and given to each of my three Daughters
 between my said three Daughters & their heirs
 forever. Lastly I appoint my beloved wife
 Mary my said Executor of this my last will
 and Testament & I do hereby revoke and disannul
 all other wills heretofore made or done and
 of record and in writing and in force of law
 heretofore let my hand and seal the seveneenth
 day of July 1798. George Waid (Seal)
