I direct that Barbara my beloved wife should she be living at my decease and wishes to comply with the above specified Article of agreement it is my wish for her to do so. In Witness whereof I Henry Hoover the Testator have to this my last Will, written on one sheet of paper, set my hand and seal this twenty eighth day of December A.D. one thousand eight hundred and fifty.

 7<sup>th</sup> I bequeath and give unto my son Abraham Wolf  
 my own Chair and two dollars

my Estate - 8<sup>th</sup> I give unto my Grand Daughter Mary Elizabeth  
 - or Ten dollars, to be paid out of my Estate.  
 9<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Phoebe Jemmy all  
 my household and kitchen furniture of whatever it may consist  
 of - 10<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Phoebe Jemmy  
 large Chest and Cupboard, also one Spinning Wheel, two Saddles,  
 one dark Bay Colt (which is her own at this time) and one Cow,  
 and two Hogs - 10<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath unto my Grand Son  
 Jacob Osburn Jemmy one Axe, one Hay, one Hoe one Drawing  
 Knife. 11<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath unto my Grand son  
 Joseph Jemmy, one Axe, one Hoe, one Hay, 1 Mallet. And  
 the balance of my property is to be sold to pay my debts, &  
 and the residue to be equally divided between my 2 Grand  
 Sons Jacob P Jemmy and Joseph Jemmy, heirs mentioned when  
 they arrive at the age of twenty one year.  
 And I constitute & appoint John my sole Executor of this  
 my last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I the said  
 Testatrix, have to this my last Will and Testament, set my  
 hand and seal this 28<sup>th</sup> day of June 1830.
