

In the name of God Amen. I Jacob Haustorger of the County of Alleghany and State of Virginia, being of full age, sound mind and disposing memory do make and publish this my last will and Testament, in manner and form following, to wit: hereby revoking all other and former wills made by me.

Item: It is my will and desire to be buried in a Christian like manner. Item: I to my son John A. Haustorger I give and bequeath the farm and tract of land upon which I now reside, together with my tract of 440 acres of land lying upon the rickpatch Mountain, and being the same which was conveyed to me by John J. Anderson & wife, the said two tracts of land, I give to my said son John upon Conditions, that he pay over to my Daughter Elizabeth A. Haustorger the sum of One thousand dollars as follows To wit: Five hundred dollars at the expiration of Twelve months from the time this will be admitted to record and five hundred dollars (the residue of the one thousand dollars) to be paid to her at the expiration of two years. He is also to pay to her the sum of the expenses of the same, she occupies, and to board her during her widowhood, and should think proper at any time to leave home, it is my will that he should be bound to defray her expenses abroad, but she shall be permitted to return to her room at any time during her Maiden life. He is also to pay over to my estate the sum of One hundred dollars. I also give and bequeath to my said Daughter Elizabeth A. Haustorger all the furniture belonging to the room herein set apart for her.

Item: To my son in law John A. Black and Rachael his wife, I give and bequeath my tract of land lying in the White rock Gap, in the County of Alleghany, being the same tract purchased by me of Douglas B. Lacy, which land I give to the said John A. Black and wife upon Condition that they pay over to my estate within Twelve months from the time this will shall be recorded the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars.

Item: It is my will and desire, that all my personal property be sold to the highest bidder, and the proceeds arising from the same together with the monies now due me, be applied to the payment of my debts.

Item: If any of my Children desire to take any of

my personal property, at the price to which it is valued, they have the liberty of doing so.

Item: I give and bequeath to William Seltzer for his good Conduct and fidelity to me, in his early life, the sum of Twenty dollars. Item: Should there be any surplus from the proceeds of my personal property, and monies now due me, after the payment of my debts, and the legacies herein bequeathed, it is my desire that such surplus be equally divided between my sons John A. Haustorger and P. Haustorger (my Daughter). Item: I constitute and appoint my son John A. Haustorger and my nephew Madison Hook, my Executors of this my last will and Testament. In witness whereof I do hereunto set my hand and affix my seal this 3rd day of July A.D. 1849.

In the Name of God Amen. I Rachael G. Scott widow of the County of Alleghany and State of Virginia being in good health sound mind and disposing Memory do hereby make this my last Will and Testament, in Manner and form following.

Firstly. I give and bequeath to my beloved Son John Pursinger the whole of my Estate both real and personal except as herein after named.

Secondly. I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter Mary Carpenter deceased (That is) To her daughters now living one hundred and fifty dollars, to be divided in equal proportions between them, in Current Money of Virginia.

Thirdly. I give and bequeath to my beloved Son Andrew Pursinger. Two hundred Dollars.

Fourthly. I give and bequeath to my beloved Sons Joseph and Alexander Pursinger each fifty Dollars, the one fifty to be paid by Joseph Pursinger to Alexander Pursinger, out of a Bond I hold on Joseph Pursinger. The balance to himself.

Fifthly. I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter Elizabeth Chicago Two hundred and fifty dollars in Current Money of Virginia.

Sixthly. I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter Susan Ross One dollar.

Seventhly. I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter Susan Ross (That is) To her Daughter Polly fifty dollars, and if she is not living to the next oldest daughter.

Eighthly. I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Nancy Callaghan fifty Dollars.

Ninthly. I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Sally Wright Fifty dollars.

Tenthly. I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter Penn Pursinger Three hundred and fifty dollars in Virginia Money, also one Horse, head, to be valued wherever fifty and seventy Dollars, also six or seven head of cattle, and the same number of sheep, and all her bedding and furniture and Clothing which she now claims, also her spinning wheel, Bureau, Bed room, set Stoves and forks, and plates.

Eleventhly. I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter Goodwill Clarkson Three hundred and fifty dollars in Virginia Money.

Twelfthly. I also bequeath my servant Daniel (commonly called Blue) to be set free at the age of thirty one, also a new suit of Clothes, and ten dollars in money, he was born the fourth day of November in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred

Thirteenth I also bequeath my servant Catharine to be set free at the same time with Daniel
 I do hereby Order Executors over appointed my beloved Son John Persinger and my Grand son Saml Carpenter &
 my Executors of this my last will and testament directing them to pay unto the said Legatee whose names the several sums bequeathed and given to them in this my last will and testament within the period of three years after my decease.
