of Life, and the Certainty of Death, and that it is appointed for
all men once to die, do make and ordain this my last will and
Testament, utterly revoking all former wills made by me.

all the remainder of my estate, which I do divide in the

raise and educate my Children during her natural life, and at
her death, to be sold both real and personal, and the money ar-
ising from the sale thereof, to be equally divided among my
Children. And I do hereby make and of date my blood wife
Elizabeth Jackson, and my friend James L. Lockhart to be the
Executors and Executor of this my last will and Testament.
