I James Henry of the Town of Burlington do hereby make
my last will and Testament in manner and form following
that is to say: It is my desire that after the payment
of my debts One thousand Dollars be left in the hands
of my Executors hereafter to be named, which sum I give

having him Educated, and if the said sum will not all
be expended for his support and education by the time he
arrives at the age of Twenty one years then the residue to
be paid to him, And if he shall depart this life before
he arrives at that age any of the said sum that will
be then unexpended, I hereby give to my Brother Samuel
Henry.

All the residue of my Estate both real
and personal of what nature or kind soever it may be,
I give to my wife Mary Rebecca Henry and my said
Brother Samuel Henry to be equally divided between them
and their heirs for ever. And it is my desire that my
said wife will be allowed to make choice of such part
of the Estate as she may prefer to make up her moiety
agreeable to valuation. If my Executors shall at any time
within twelve months after my decease consider from
the good conduct of my Negro man Spencer that he
will be entitled to his freedom it is my wish that
they liberate him and if his conduct will be such

 null and testaments of mine do hereby make and declare
 my last will and testament to be as follows.

I humbly commend my immortal soul to the
 merciful disposal of its divine author.

I desire my body to be buried in the Presbyterian
 Churchyard in Lewisburg, Va.

I bequeath to my beloved and affectionate wife
 Mary Ann her legal right of Dower in my house & lot
 No 90 in Covington Va. also the best bed with its
 furniture & bedstead also an Chest & Bureau
 and the set of new China etc. and also my Cig. and
 harness to her and her heirs forever.

I bequeath the six silver table spoons marked
 A.M.T. to my Daughter Virginia & and to her
 heirs forever.

I bequeath the six silver tea spoon marked
 A.M.T. and my surveying compass marked A.P. 7.

I bequeath a new silver Bible to be bought to Hugh
 I. Young the son of Matthew Young of Covington County
 Va. and to his heirs forever.

I bequeath my uniform Coat & sword & sword belt
 & spurs & gait to my brother Stuart Taylor and to
 his heirs forever.

I bequeath all the residue of my clothing
 to my old coloured friend Cyrus who lives with
 Stuart Taylor.

I desire my two engineering books and all the
 bundles of letters & field notes & plates & newspaper
 in my office to remain in the hands of my
 Executor for the future use of my son Henry
 and to be given to him when he comes to
 maturity.

I bequeath my personal property to my wife
 Mary Ann & to her heirs forever.
 I bequeath my house and lot described survey
 in Covington Va. to my son Henry Taylor and to
 his heirs forever subject to my wife's Dower.

I desire that all the rest of my property of
 every description not above named be sold on
 the best terms and all my dues be collected
 and that out of the proceeds all my just debts
 be paid and the balance if any equally
 divided between my son Henry and my Daughter
 Virginia and applied to their education & support
 as occasion may require.

I desire Isaac Steel claim against me now
 in suit to be resisted until he shall have
 caused the claim of John Wilson & his wife
 in the said lot No 90 to be conveyed
 to my son Henry and his legal representatives
 in proper form and no longer be received
 said claim in part payment of said lot.
