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In the name of God Amen:
I John ^{Wesley} Son of the County of Allegheny
and State of Virginia, being in good health,
but of limited mind and memory, do make
and ordain this my last Will and Testa-
ment in manner hereinafter as follows:-

First, I give and bequeath to each
of my three Girls Alice, Polly and Rebecca
the Beds and furniture, which each of them
at present claim as their own, to them and
their heirs forever. -

Secondly, - It is my Will and desire, that
all my real estate property, except the Beds
before mentioned, be sold at public sale
and after paying all my just debts, the
proceeds of such sale, to be divided equally
among my three daughters, Alice, Polly and Rebecca, with
the exception of fifteen dollars to each of
Rebecca's children, namely, Isaac P. Yeale
and Elizabeth B. Yeale, which shall be
appropriated towards their education. -

Thirdly, - It is my Will and desire, that
my Tract of Land, wherein I now reside
shall be sold as soon as possible after my
death, provided it can be sold for any
thing like its value, and the proceeds of
such sale, to be equally divided between
my four Daughters, Alice, Polly, Rebecca and
Ruth. Provided, that one of Rebecca's
part, the one half shall be equally divided
between her two children, Isaac P. Yeale
and Elizabeth B. Yeale; and if either of
the children should die, then his or her

her part shall go to the other, and if both should
die, the same, both his and her parts shall revert
to their Mother again; - and one of Ruth's half
of said Land, shall be paid to her two chil-
dren John Wesley Stafford and Betsy Yeale.

Stafford, hereby clothed with power, to be disposed
of, as he may think proper. -

Fourthly, - It is my Will and desire, that
my Daughter Ruth Stafford shall have no
share of my Estate whatever, except her part
of the Land aforesaid. -

Fifthly, - It is my Will and desire, in
the event of my Executors not being able to
sell my Land as aforesaid, that it shall
be rented out to the best advantage, for
such term of years, as may be made by my Executors as aforesaid. -
And that one half of the rent shall be appro-
priated annually to the improvement of the
place, as my Executors may think proper. -
And the other half to be equally divided
between my three Daughters, Alice, Polly, and
Rebecca. -

Sixthly, - It is my Will and desire,
that whenever my Land shall be sold by my
Executor aforesaid, that the payment shall not
be lengthened to more than one or two
years, and a Deed of Trust shall be taken
on the Land to secure such payments. -

Seventhly, - I give and bequeath to my
three Sons, Joseph Yeale, Hugh Yeale & John
Yeale, one dollar each, to them and their
heirs forever. -

And lastly, I do make and constitute Co^l. John Crow of this County and State aforesaid, Executor to this my last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto affixed my hand and seal this twenty ninth Day of May, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty three.
