} and mind Will and Testament. -
First I will that all my last Debts be payed and for
that purpose I direct, that Money from the sale of
a tract of Land sold by me to Mrs White be
appropriated for that purpose; also a notice
Tract of Land lying with the back Run be sold at public
sale or otherwise and the money arising from the
sale be appropriated in like manner to the same
to have full power to make the deeds to the above
tracts of Land. - Secondly, I give and bequeath to
my beloved wife Mary Ann the third of the
Plantation where on I now reside during her
life time, also the two thirds of all my household
and Kitchen furniture, to be disposed of as she may
think proper. - Thirdly, I give and bequeath to my
Daughter Jane we are all the property I have
given her heretofore with twenty shillings to be
payed by my Executor as soon as sale can be made
and money collected. Fourthly, I bequeath to my
Daughter Polly twenty shillings with the other
property I have given her to be payed as I have
directed above. - Fifthly, I give and bequeath
to my Daughter Nelly Tolbert twenty shillings
with the other property I have given her heretofore,
the twenty shillings to be payed as I have directed
heretofore. - Sixthly, I give and bequeath to
my Daughter Mary Ann McCallister forty dol-
lars with one third of all my house hold
and Kitchen furniture to her forever. -
Seventhly, I give and bequeath unto my son
James McCallister the following property to wit:

I release to Rachel Miller (wid. Bryan),
 the living five dollars she owes me
 I especially desire my children to be raised
 in piety, industry and economy avoiding extravagance
 I hereby appoint and declare Dr. Jacob
