At Alleghany County Court May Term 1837

At Court of law to my beloved son John  
 Wolf deceased was  
 produced in Court for probate and was proved  
 by the Oaths of Susan Brown and Charles  
 Brown subscribing witnesses thereto and the  
 same is ordered to be recorded and an  
 appeal is prayed in the case by Jacob Wolf which is  
 granted to him upon his giving Bond and Security  
 as the law directs. Hereupon on motion of Abraham  
 Wolf one of the Executors named in said will the  
 Executorship of the testator is granted to him  
 and he together with Charles Brown Michael  
 Maxwell son Peter Pence and George Larrison  
 his securities entered into and acknowledged their  
 Bond in the penalty of \$1000. payable to the  
 Justices now sitting and conditioned as the  
 Law directs and the said John Wolf took the oath  
 prescribed by Law & Letters Testamentary are granted  
 him in due form John Herbert the  
 other Executor named in said will

Dear Sir, I have just been informed  
by Nathan Wolf sen<sup>r</sup> and son that I am chosen  
by John Wolf for one of his Executors, and  
I do now inform the Court of Alleghany  
County that I can serve.

Now all men by these presents that I  
Nathan Wolf of the County of Shelby and  
State of Indiana do hereby certify and  
of sound mind and memory do make and  
constitute this as my last Will and Testament  
and hereby revoking and annulling all  
other and former Wills by me made.  
First I Will that my body may be decently  
buried in a good and Christian-like manner  
and a high Mass built over my Grave.  
Second, I Will that all my just debts <sup>may</sup> be  
paid out of my personal property.  
Third, I Will that all the balance of my  
personal property after my Debts have been  
paid shall be remain to my beloved wife  
Catharine Keen so long as she shall remain  
my Widow.

Fourth, I Will that the rents and profits  
of all my <sup>real</sup> Estate shall remain and belong  
to my beloved wife, during the time  
that she remains my Widow and at

the time of her death in her intermarriage  
with any other person than the said and  
properly ~~disposed~~ <sup>disposed</sup> of the  
same shall accrue and belong to my  
beloved Daughter Elizabeth.

Fifth, I Will that at the death of my  
beloved wife Catharine or her ~~decease~~ <sup>death</sup>  
that all of my personal goods and chattels  
shall be equally divided between my two  
Children Elizabeth & William.

Sixth, I Will that my Executors after my  
decease do finish all my business on my  
real Estate in order that the same may  
be settled or leased to advantage.

Seventh, I do hereby constitute and appoint  
my beloved wife Catharine Keen and her  
father ~~simplex~~ <sup>joint</sup> ~~executor~~ <sup>executors</sup> of that part of my Estate that  
lies in the State of Virginia, and Conrad  
Overlief of Versailles Ripley County Indiana  
Executor of that part of my Estate that lies  
in the State of Indiana.

In Testimony hereof I have hereunto set  
my hand and seal this 27<sup>th</sup> day of January  
in the year of our Lord One thousand eight  
hundred and twenty nine.
