

In the name of God Amen I, Augustus Morgan of the County of Allegheny and State of Virginia being in full health but of sound mind and disposing memory do make this my last Will and Testament—

1st. I Will and bequeath to my Wife Fanny Morgan all my landed estate in the County of Allegheny Virginia to have and to hold during her natural life. If she should sell it is my wish that the proceeds of the said land shall be invested in land for her and her Children. 2nd. I desire that my three eldest Children, James W. Elizabeth Anne and Barbara M shall receive as they become of age the sum of thirty dollars each to be paid out of my personal estate. And I hereby appoint William Cunningham guardian of my three Children above named—

3rd. I desire my Wife to sell privately so much of my personal estate as will pay my funeral expenses and just debts. in case there is not money enough left to meet them.

4th. I Will and bequeath to my Son James W Morgan one half of all the Horses, Cattle, Sheep and Hogs that are now on the home place after my decease, and my Wife to have to dispose of as he thinks. 5th. I hereby appoint Wright Smith my Executor of this will and that he shall receive all other debts my wife and myself have made. Given under my hand and seal this 1st day of January our hundred and eight hundred and fifty five
