 by the Oaths of Archibald M. Shucard
 & Robert Shucard & thereupon the said
 Will is ordered to be Recorded.

 use of my understanding do make and ordain
 that my last will and testament in the

 had by Moses Mann after the payment of
 my just Debts to be for him and his heirs
 forever and no other person.

 keep it inviolate and approved What I have said
 by Alexander McElwain and Charles McElwain
 Executors of this my last Will and Testament
 hereby revoking and making void all other
 Wills made by me and acknowledging this my
 last Will and Testament In Witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand and seal this
 twenty fourth day of November eighteen hundred

I Michael Mallon of the County of Loudoun in the State of Virginia do hereby make and publish my Last Will & Testament in manner and form following that is to say First: I give to my wife Christina Mallon one Negro Girl named & called Sally to be possessed by her during her natural life and after her decease to be sold with her. Second (if any) to the highest bidder in the family and the monies arising from such sale to equally divided among all my sons and daughters also I give to my wife the parlor room of my House with full liberty of the other rooms adjoining the same (if she desire them) during her natural life also any monies I may be in possession of at my decease to be held and kept by her during her natural life the subject to pay all funeral expenses & necessary debts (Also one Horse head (the choice of my stock) Saddle & Bridle two Cows that she may choose out of my stock four sheep out of the flock two Beds & furniture (her choice) One folding bed dining Table one Bureau and Table furniture such as she may choose for and during her natural life and after her decease I give the same to my sons & daughters herein after mentioned to be equally divided among them & to be enjoyed by them & their heirs forever. Secondly I give to my son Jacob Mallon one thousand Dollars in hand paid to be enjoyed by him & his heirs Thirdly to my Daughter Barbara Dupler one hundred pounds in hand paid to be enjoyed by her and her heirs forever. Fourthly I give to my son George Mallon all that tract or parcel of land on Potts Creek whereon he now lives to be enjoyed by him and his heirs forever after paying

the said balance of said sum to be enjoyed by him and his heirs forever. Fifthly I give to my Daughter Elizabeth Guinnamer one Negro Boy named Ben at Forty pounds an hundred fifty Dollars in Cash which she has received also fifty Dollars to be receipted for when paid to be enjoyed by her and her heirs forever. Sixthly I give to my Daughter Catharine Mallon one Negro Girl named Judith at Forty pounds and two hundred Dollars in Cash to be receipted for when paid to be enjoyed by her and her heirs forever. Eighthly I give to my son John Mallon one Negro Boy named Moses at Forty pounds also all the lands attached to my present residence (including the same) and the land adjoining the same on each side of the same. Also one Horse head (if received before my decease to be receipted for) to be held and enjoyed by him & his heirs forever after paying an hundred & eighty pounds as here after directed. I also give to my son John Mallon my Shille gun & one Negro woman named Susan to be under the direction of him & his mother during her natural life and at her decease to be possessed by him & his heirs forever and as to the residue of my Estate both real and personal not already disposed of I desire that my Executors herein after mentioned will as soon as practicable after my decease proceed to sell Tilar Hens Andy Abbott & Sampson with the increase of Susan & Sally (if any) to the highest bidder among my Children & not to Strangers. I also direct that they may attend to the sale of such land that they may attend. Also to sell that tract of land which I own in the Ward of Laska on
