

I Robert M Kincaid, of the County of Alleghany and State of Virginia, do hereby make my last Will and Testament in Manner and form following that is to say.

1st. I bequeath my Soul to God who gave it.

2nd. — It is my Will and desire, that all of my just debts and funeral expenses be paid out of the Money, Bonds, Notes, Executions, and Accounts &c, which I may be possessed of at the time of my decease. —

3rd. — I give and bequeath unto Archibald Kincaid infant Son of Andrew Kincaid Senr of Alleghany County, and Andrew Kincaid, infant Son of William M Kincaid deceased of the County aforesaid, the residue of all my Money, Bonds, Notes, Executions and Accounts to be equally divided between them, and to be enjoyed by them and their heirs forever. I also give and bequeath unto the above named infant Children, Archibald Kincaid and Andrew Kincaid, my entire Interest in the landed estate of my Father Robert Kincaid deceased, which is one sixth of the same, which will descend to me or my heirs, after the death of Joseph M. Pomeroy who has a life estate in the same, to be enjoyed by them and their heirs forever, and to be equally divided between them. — It is also my Will, that the Money, arising from the legacy left to Archibald Kincaid and Andrew Kincaid infant Children as above stated, be put out at interest, by my Executor, herein after named, until they shall respectively attain the Age of Seventeen Years old, and then to be applied in aiding them to obtain a Classical education, and if the amount be sufficient to aid them in studying some useful profession; it is also my wish and desire that the Parents and Guardian of the above named infant Children give them a good English education, before they attain the above mentioned age of Seventeen Years old.

4th. — I give and bequeath unto Ann Kincaid, Wife of Andrew Kincaid Senr of Alleghany County, my Bed and Bedding, and my large family Bible, to be enjoyed by her and her heirs forever. —

5th. — I give and bequeath unto James C Kincaid and Thomas Kincaid Sons of the above named Andrew Kincaid Senr all my wearing Apparel to be divided between them as they may suit them. —

6th. — I give and bequeath unto the above named James

C Kincaid my Silver Watch, my Trunk, my Pistol, all my Books and all other property not herein before particularly disposed of to be enjoyed by him and his heirs forever. — And lastly, I do hereby constitute and appoint my Friend Samuel Kincaid Executor of this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all other or former Wills or Testaments by me heretofore made. —
