First My desire is that my Executor hereinafter named do Cause my Body after my decease to be decently buried, and that the expenses attending the same be paid out of my Estate. I give and bequeath unto my Wife Nancy during her natural life all the Estate which I may be possessed of except One Bay Mare (Bought of Mr Stearns) which I bequeath unto my son Jacob Sanders. After the decease of my Wife it is my Will and desire that the property thereby bequeathed to her, (or so much thereof as may not be consumed in her maintenance) be equally divided amongst all my Children. I constitute and appoint my Wife Nancy Sanders Executor of this my last Will and Testament. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 21st day of July 1836.
