which Sale he shall give Publick notice by Advertising the
same at such places as shall be necessary for that purpose
and in order to secure the payment of money I do direct
that my ^d Executor shall take Bonds with good security
for the same Payable two Years after the day of Sale with
Interest from the date It is further my will & desire that
my said Executor shall receive the money arising by the
Sale aforesaid with the Interest thereon & pay it to the
several legates as hereafter shall be directed to wit, to
Geoffrey Murrel one seventh part to Joseph Hightower,
one seventh part, to Nathaniel Booth one seventh part,
to my Daughter Sarah Mayes one seventh part, to my
Grand Daughter Agnes Clardy one seventh part, to my
Grand Daughter Mary Hightower Daughter of John
Hightower one seventh part which s^d several Sums I do
give and bequeath to the s^d several Legates and their heirs
forever and I do give and bequeath the residue of the Money
arising by the sale aforesaid being one seventh part to my
said Executor for the use of my Daughter Lucy commonly
called Lucy Miller, five Pounds of which I direct him to
lay out in the purchase of such necessaries as the said Lucy
shall be in want of and deliver her as soon as the s^d Money
shall be received & the same can be purchased and the
residue of the s^d seventh part to put to Interest & annually
collect & lay out the like Sum of five Pounds for the s^d
Lucy in the same manner as before mentioned until the
whole shall be expended and laid out for her And
lastly I do constitute and appoint my Grand Son John
Crop to be my whole and sole Executor of this my last
