 already possessed him with to him and his Heirs forever
 I then give and confirm to my son Josiah Ellington all the Estate I have
 already possessed him with to him and his Heirs forever
 I then give & confirm to my son Zezekiah Ellington all the Estate
 I have already possessed him with to him & his heirs forever
 I then give & bequeath to my son Enochward Ellington four Hundred
 Acres of Land the lower half of the Tract of land I bought of Edward
 Thwait adjoining Gunn to him and his Heirs forever
 I also give and bequeath to my said son Enoch one Negro man named
 Yark to him and his Heirs forever
 I then give & bequeath to my son Stephen Ellington two Hundred &
 Fifty Acres of Land the Upper part of the Tract whereon I now live
 to him & his heirs forever I also give my said son Stephen one negro
 Woman Named Jonny to him & his Heirs forever
 I then give & confirm to my Daughter Lucy Samner all the Estate
 I have already possessed her with to her & her heirs forever
 I then give and confirm to my Daughter Martha Motley all the
 Estate I have already possessed her with to her & her heirs forever
 I then give & confirm to my Daughter Abedience Evans all the Estate
 I have already possessed her with to her & her heirs forever

I Now Give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Ellington two negro
Slaves to wit, Sammy & Dinah, to her & her heirs forever

I Now Give to my Loving Wife Martha Ellington one hundred acres
of Land the Lower part of the Tract whereon I now Live Including
The Plantation during her Natural life and After her decease I give
And bequeath the said one Hundred Acres of Land to my son Stephen
Ellington to him and his heirs forever

I Now Give and bequeath to my Loving wife Martha Ellington
all the remainder of my Estate, be it of what kind soever, after paying
All my Just Debts but that she shall give the said Estate at her
decease to such or so many of my Children as she shall think proper
