that my Executors purchase Slaves therewith, & them to be divided as
my Estate before Directed I constitute & Appoint my brother Thomas
Bolling & Hunford and my friend M^r Vivion Broching Executors
of this my Last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal the day & year above
