and weak but of sound mind and memory thanks
be to Almighty God do make and ordain this my
last Will and Testament in manner and form
following. I give and bequeath to my Son David
Gresham the upper half of the Tract of Land
I now live on I give it to him and his heirs forever
I give and bequeath to my Son Anthony Gresham
the lower half of the above mentioned Tract of Land
I give it to him and his heirs forever
I give to my Son William Winston Gresham Two
hundred Pounds Current Money to be laid out
in a piece of Land by my Ex^r hereafter named
I give it to him and his heirs forever
I lend to my beloved Wife all my Estate Real &
Personal during her life or Widowhood to bring
up and Educate my Children and if my s^r Wife
should marry then my Will is that she take a
Childs Part and that all the rest of my Negroes
and other Personal Estate be equally divided
at that time amongst all my Children or their
heirs and my Will further is that my s^r wife
do give to either of my Children at their coming
of lawfull age or Marry's so many Negroes &
other Estate as she may think the Estate can
afford at that time and my Will further is, that
if my said Wife should Marry the part that she
takes as a Childs Part at her death may be equally
divided amongst all my Children or their heirs

and lastly I constitute and appoint my beloved Wife
my brother Charles Greenhaw my friends John Austin
and William Brittain Exrs of this my last Will and
Testament revoking all former or other Wills heretofore
by me made In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and affixed my seal this Nineteenth day of
September in the Year of our Lord Christ One thousand seven
hundred and seventy one.

to the highest bidder at Publick Vendue and out of the
Money arising from such sale all my Just Debts and
funeral charges be paid Secondly I give and bequeath
my Sister Catharine, two Daughters Maria Dildey and
Gutlieb Dildey the Daughters of Peter Dildey all
the remainder of my Estate to them and their Heirs
for ever they live in the County of Bransenburg in the
Town of Roppin in the King of Prussia's Dominion
the Money to be remitted by my Executors in Bills of
Exchange or current Money to some substantial Merchant
in London and by him remitted to some substantial
Merchant in Hamburg and by him to be sent or
delivered to Maria Dildey and Gutlieb Dildey to be
equally divided between them Thirdly I give to each
of my Executors the sum of Five pounds current Money
to be paid out of my Estate for their trouble
Lastly I do constitute and appoint my friends Benjamin
Ward John Scott and Thomas Jones all of Amelia County
Executors of this my last Will and Testament In
