I then Give and bequeath to my son Asiah Jackson that Tract of
Land whercon he now lives Dividing from my Plantation by a branch
that heads up near the lower end of Union Clements Plantation
down the said branch to a Church tree in William Jacksons line
on the South side of Mayes branch to him & his heirs forever

I then Give & bequeath to my Daughter Mary Jackson one negro
Woman named Lucy & her increase to her & her heirs forever

I then Give and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Jackson
one Negro girl named Rose & her increase to her & her heirs forever

I then Give and bequeath to my Daughter Priscilla Jackson
one Negro girl named Red & her increase to her & her heirs forever

I likewise give & bequeath to each of my Daughters before men-
tioned one Cow & calf apiece to them & their heirs forever

I then Give and bequeath to my son Francis Jackson the
Plantation whercon I now live & the Remainder of my lands
not before given to him & his heirs Forever, I likewise give
unto my son Francis Jackson the Remainder of my Negroes
by name Pat & Tom, Madracks & Jude & their Increase
likewise the Remainder of my Stock of all kinds and

Household Furniture with all necessary Utensils whatsoever
to me belonging only he to Pay my Just Debts to him & his ..
Tiers forever my Will & Desire is that my Daughters have the
Privilege of living with their brother Francis during the time
they continue single & without & Ordain my Friends Benjamin
Lockett & Simon Clement whole & sole Executors of this my ..
Last Will & Testament hereby revoking all other Wills ..
Heretofore made, appoint this only to be my last Will.
