make and ordain this to be my last Will and Testament
and do give demise and dispose of in manner and
form following Viz I give and bequeath to my Son James
Foster One hundred and twenty five Acres of Land in the
County of Prince Edward it being part of a Tract of Land
which I purchased of James Atwood I desire he may
have it joining the plantation on which he dwells on
I also give to my Son James Foster one Negro man called
Gloster to him and his heirs for ever I give and bequeath
to my Son Abraham Forrest Foster Two hundred acres of

Not it known to all men by these Presents that I George
Foster of Amelia County hath made and declared my last Will
and Testament in writing being dated the Twentieth day of
December One thousand, seven hundred and seventy one & the
said George Foster by this present Codicil do Ratify and
confirm my said last Will and Testament But whereas my
Son Travis Foster is well in this my present Will One hundred
Pounds in cash besides other profits But my will and desire is
that the One hundred Pounds so willd shall be omitted &
he abstained from any Enjoyment of the same in attorney &
in behalf of that hundred pound cash my Will and desire
is that the Tract of land where my present situation is
which is containing six hundred Acres shall be equally
Divided between my two Sons Travis Foster and Giles Foster
when the said Travis Foster comes to the Age of Twenty one
Years and that according to my Executors discretion here
mentioned in this my last Will and Testament which shall
be to them and their heirs for ever And my Will and meaning
is that this Codicil be adjudged to be a part and piece
of my last Will and Testament and that all things therein
mentioned and containd be fully and truly performed and
as fully and amply in every respect as if the same were
declared and set down in my last Will & Testament
