That it knowne to all men by these Presents that I George Foster of Amelia County hath made and declared my last Will and Testament in writing being dated the Fourteenth day of December One thousand seven hundred and eighty one & the said George Foster by this present Codicil do Ratify and confirm my said last Will and Testament But whereas my Son Travis Foster is still in this my present Will One hundred Pounds in cash beside other profits But my will and desire is that the One hundred Pounds so will'd shall be omitted & he abstain from any Enjoyment of the same in Money or in behalf of that hundred pounds lass my Will and desire is that the Tract of Land where my present situation is which is containing Six hundred Acres shall be equally Divided between my two Sons Travis Foster and Giles Foster when the said Travis Foster comes to the Age of Twenty one years and that according to my Executors discretion here mentioned in this my last Will and Testament which shall be to them and their heirs for ever & as my Will and meaning is that this Codicil be adjudged to be a Part and Peace of my last Will and Testament and that all things therein mentioned and contained be fully and truly performed and as fully and amply in every respect as if the same were declared and set down in my last Will & Testament Witness whereunto I have here at my hand and affixed my Seal this Twenty fourth day of March One thousand seven hundred and eighty two
