Grand son Dudley Clark) and that she shall not be put to the uses
of my land but keep it whole during her Life

Now I give the rest of my Estate after my Wife's Die that I did
not give above in the same to be Equally divided between the
Above mentioned George Will & George Full son of my Grand daug-
ter Mary. And Lastly I do leave constituted & appoint my son
Henry Clark to be my heir and sole Executor of this my last Will and
Testament
