Once to die do make and ordain this my last Will & Testament
in Manner following (Viz) first of all I give my Soul into
the hands of God that gave it me, not doubting but at the
General Resurrection I shall receive the same again and my
body to the Earth to be buried in a Christian & decent Manner at
the discretion of my Executors hereafter named and as for
what worldly Estate it hath Pleased God to bestow on me
I give demise & dispose in the manner & form following
I give and devise unto my Eldest Daughter vizt
Command to her & hers forever one Negro girl named Sa-
rah and her Increase and one Feather bed & Furniture
to her & her heirs forever
Item I give and devise unto my daughter Anne Dawson
and to her heirs one Negro girl named Winney & her Increase
and one Feather bed & Furniture to her & her heirs forever
Item I give & devise unto my son John Green & to his heirs
one Negro boy named Isaac & one hundred and fifty pounds
Cash paid in hand towards paying for his land where he
now Lives &c. Item I give and devise to my daughter
Martha Jones upon Condition one Negro girl named Di-
nah and her Increase & one Negro boy named Dick (if
John Jones will make over two Hundred Acres of land
where his Plantation and Houses is, Balsam Jones lives, according
to promise otherwise the said Negro to return to my Estate again
Item I give & devise to my Daughter Mary Whitehead two
Negro boys Named, Jack & Charles to her & her heirs forever
Item I give & devise unto my Daughter Milley Harper
Two young Negroes Named York & Dilcey a Feather bed & Furniture
&c. Item I give and devise to my daughter Fanny Green
Two young negro boys Named Lemmy & Plancy, a girl Named
Silvai with her Increase to her & her heirs forever &c.
Item I give & devise unto my son George Green & to his heirs one

Negro boy Named Phill, & a Negro Woman Named Sue at the Age of Twenty & Mingo at his Mothers death and three Hundred Acres of Land being the Plantations Whereon I now Live to him & his Heirs forever.

Item I give & devise to my Daughter Lucy Green two young Negros a boy Named Sterling & a girl Named Lydia and a Negro Woman Named Lucy, to be delivered to my daughter at the Age of eighteen years of Age, and it is my desire if the Negro boy Sterling should die before my daughter comes to eighteen years, that my Estate pay her twenty pounds Cash to her and her Heirs forever.

Item it is my Will & desire that if either of my young Children above Named should die, in their Nonage or before Marriage, that their Part or Parts should be Equally Divided between the rest of my Children.

Item I leave the Use of my Plantations whereon I now live to my Beloved Wife Lucy Green During her Natural life and a Negro Wench Named Frank, Tom Mingo with all the Stocks, cattle hogs, sheep, horses for the Plantations Use, with all Plantation Utensils, & household Furniture, Kitchen Furniture &c

Item my Will & desire is that at my Wifes decease for my Daughter Elizabeth Hammond to have my Negro man Tom and my daughter Anne Lawson to have my Negro woman Frank.

Item, all the ~~Rest~~ of my Estate not already given away at my Wifes decease to be equally Divided between all my Children with an Equal Division, . . . Item I last of all do ordain constitute and Appoint my Well beloved Wife Lucy Green, John Green and Mary Harpers to be my True & Trusty friends to be my whole & sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 25th day of September Anno Domini one thousand Seven hundred & Seventy Six (my Will & desire is that my Estate be not Appraised)
