being Certain that I must shortly put off, this Tabernacle and
Uncertain of the time when, so therefore look upon it to be Expedi-
-ent to set my house in Order by making my last Will and
Testament
I recommend my Soul to God in Expectation of Blessed Immortali-
-ty through the Redemption that is in Christ Jesus and my
Slave to mingle with Fellow Way till the morning of the Resurrecti-
-on, as Touching the small portion of Temporal good things that

God has been Pleased to entrust me with I leave to be disposed
of in the following manner Viz.

I give to my wife Margaret Simoley one Feather bed, one horse
and Saddle and three Negroes Yorkshire and Hannah his wife
And Old Jane to be her own Property forever to dispose of As
she Will, And my desire is that the rest of my Estate shall be
Equally Divided among my Children by lot the Oldest Child
To have the first lot and then the Next Oldest till they all have
taken their lots I also appoint William Ford, Joseph Jackson
and Joshua Chaffin the Executors of this my last Will & Testament
In Confirmation of the aforesaid I have hereunto set my hand I
Affixed my Seal this thirteenth day of March one thousand
seven hundred & seven A.D.
