appointed for all men once to die, I do therefore make, constitute  
and appoint this to be my last Will & Testament humbly giving  
my soul to Almighty God that gave it me & my body to be buried  
decently by my executors hereafter Named, and as for what worldly  
estate it hath pleased Almighty God to bless me with, in this life  
I give and bequeath in Manner and form following giving  
and bequeath my Land to my Brother Burton Hudson & my  
Brother Samuel Hudson to them their Heirs & assigns forever  
to

To be Equally Divided between them in the most convenient manner  
to suit each of their Tracts of Land.

I him I give and bequeath all the remaining part of my Estate to  
be equally Divided amongst my two brother & my two Sisters here  
= after Named viz, my Brother Burton Hudson my Brother Sam.  
Hudson my Sister Mary Hudson & my Sister Magdalene Hud-  
son to them their Heirs and assigns forever, Lastly I do hereby  
Appoint my brother Burton Hudson Executor of this my last Will  
and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand  
and Seal this twenty second day of February 1777
