In the Name of God Amen I John Johnson of the County of Sta-
 tia being infirm & weak of Body but in perfect mind & memory
 do make & ordain this my Last Will & Testament as Follows.
 I thin my Will and desire is that my beloved Wife Elizabeth may
 have the Use & Possession of my Land & plantation whereon I now live
 so Long as she continue my Widow and also all my Slaves & personal
 Estate of Every Kind whatever, which I lend her for her support.

But do not Impower her to dispose of any part thereof or of the profits of the same but order that the Whole with the profits thereof be kept Together for the purposes hereafter mentioned

Item my desire is that Immediately after my said Wifes death or Marriage that all my Negroes & personal Estate of Every Kind may be Equally divided between my 6 sons & viz. John, Jesse, John, Gerrard James and William or their Legal Representatives, which I give to them & their heirs forever But as my son Gerrard dies me thirty two pounds on bond I order that the same be accounted for by him & that the said Bond & Interest be Enclosed in my Personal Estate before mentioned I then Give and bequeath to my son William all that Tract of Land & plantation whereon I now live after my Wifes death or Marriage which I give to him & his heirs forever, having already given Lands to his other Brothers

Item I give & bequeath to my Grandson Mourning Johnson one Leather Bed and Furniture of 10 pounds value at the least to him & his heirs forever

Item my desire is that if during my Wifes Widowhood my Executors the After named should find that there is not land sufficient to Work all the Negroes to Advantage that then they hire out so many of the said Negroes as they may think proper, to such persons as shall use them Well & Not Abuse them and that the said Hire may be appropriated to my Wifes Support & the bringing up the young Negroes & to the Poor House I then it is my Will and desire that when my Estate shall come to be Divided According to this my Will that my Executors or such of them as shall take upon them the Execution thereof may Choose two honest Neighbours such as they may think proper to Assist them to lay off the same in six Lots in the most equitable way they can and that my six sons before mentioned or their Legal representatives draw for the same and be Accountable to each Other According to the Value of the Lot they draw And Lastly I constitute & Appoint my Friends Francis Anderson & Christo. Ford & my son William Executors of this my Will revoking and Making void all former Wills by me Made in Witness whereof I have set my Hand & affixed my seal this 23^d day of March 1772
