

My Will and Desire is that my two Negroes Call'd & known by the Name of Abram & Ebo, and all the rest of my Estate should be sold and after my debts and other affairs settled it is my Desire, that the Whole of my Estate should be Equally Divided between three of my Daughters Viz: Jane Rice, Sally Blankinghip & Molly Blankinghip after each of their Legacies is settled that was left them by their Father, Except thirty pounds Virginia currency Which if ever Susan & Stephens arrived to the Age of fifteen or Marries it is also my desire she should be paid that sum James Rice my Son in Law & John Winn Executors of this my Last Will and Testament as Witnesses my hand & Seal this

I John Winn of Amelia County in perfect Sense & Memory do make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament as follows,  
First I will that all my debts be paid . . . . .  
I will that my Executors hereafter mentioned deliver to my Daughter Susanna Winn, when she Arrives to the Age of Eighteen years or Marries) seven Slaves to consist of male & female of the same Value of those I gave to my Daughter Jane Eses before her Marriage as also of every other Article of Value and kind as they were When delivered to my said daughter Jane all which I give devise and bequeath to my said Daughter Susanna & her Heirs forever and declare the same free from any Manner of Contribution, in aid of any other devise herein contained

To my Son Richard Winn, I give devise and bequeath in  
year after the time of my death, Two Negroes viz. Beaton and  
and send to him the said Richard Winn & his Heirs for ever the  
S. Negroes to go towards the support of my Wife until the time  
of Delivery. I will that my wife have possession of my  
dwelling house & a sufficient maintenance out of my Estate,  
To my sons John & Charles Winn I give devise & bequeath  
all the rest & residue of my Estate, including all my lands  
Tenements & Hereditaments, Slaves & personal estate -  
Equally to be divided between my said sons John and  
Charles Winn, in one year after the time of my death to  
them the said John & Charles Winn respectively & their  
heirs forever, I Nominate constitute and appoint  
my Wife Susanna Winn Executrix, Truman Epes & my sons  
John & Charles Winn Executors of this my last Will & Testa-  
ment; hereby revoking all former wills by me made and  
confirming this alone to be my last Will & Testament which  
I seal Publish & declare the third day of March in the year  
of Our Lord one thousand Seven hundred & Eighty
