Probate thereof, and I do hereby revoke disannul & disallow all
Former Will or Wills by me heretofore made either by word of
Mouth or Writing ratifying and confirming this & no other to be
my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have here

Joshua Hawks of Brauley Parish in the County of Amelia planter
In Perfect mind & memory thanks be to God for the same

And Calling to mind the Mortality of my body & knowing that it is Appointed for all men once to die do make & Ordain this my last will and Testament that is to say Principally and First of All I give and Recommend my Soul into the hands of God that gave it me and for my body Recommend it to the earth to be Buried in a Christian like and decent manner at the discretion of my Executors noting Doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty Power of God and as Touching such Worldly Estate wherewith it hath Pleased God to bless me with in this life I give devise & dispose of the same in manner following that is to say

I Item Give and bequeath to my son Richard Hawks all the Land to the North side of my Peasey branch that he lives on and also five Shillings Sterling; I Item Give and bequeath to my son John Hawks all the land on the South side of the said Peasey branch in the forks, I Item Give & bequeath to my son Joshua Hawks the remainder of the said Tract of land which contains the plantation wherupon I now live on, I Item Give & bequeath to my son George Hawks one hundred and fifty Acres land wherupon he has built his house on the Meadows Branch

I Item Give and bequeath to my son John Hawks & James Hawks the remainder part of the Tract of land that George Hawks has built on to be Equally Divided between them Two

I Item Give and bequeath to my Daughter Frances Sammons one Negro Girl named Rachel & also five Shillings Sterling

I Item Give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary Hawks one Feather bed and Furniture, - I Item Give and bequeath

to my Daughter Rebecca Hawks one bed and Furniture

I Item Give and bequeath to my Daughter Lewis Hawks one Feather bed and Furniture; - I Item I lend to my beloved

Wife Anjalice Hawks all my Estate that I am possessed with at my decease Real & Personal of Negroes, Stock of horses, hogs, Cattle & sheep also all my household & Kitchen Furniture During her life also all my working Utensils and After her Decease then to be Equally Divided between my Six Children that I shall name here under George Hawks John Hawks

Joshua Hawks, Mary Hawks, Rebecca Hawks & Lowsee -
Hawks, and if any of the ^{said} Six Children should die before they
should have any heirs then their said Estate shall be divid-
ed Among the Surviving Children

Item I do also appoint my beloved wife Angelica Hawks
and my son George Hawks Executor and Executrix of this my
Last Will and Testament and I do hereby utterly revoke &
disannul all & every other will and Legacies bequeathed by me
in any wise before this time & named In Witnesses whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and Year

At a Court held for Amelia County the 28th Sept. 1775.
This Will was proved by the Oaths of two of the

directs Cert. was granted them for obtaining probat in

Will and Testament in manner following that is to say
I certify This is my Will and desire that After my Just and
Lawful debts are paid, that I give devise and bequeath the re-
mainder of my Estate in manner and form Following
Item I lend to my loving Wife Mary Moulson during her
Natural life one fifth part of my Slaves in five equal parts
to be divided and she to take her choice, and all my Stocks of every
kind and the Use of the Tract of land whereon I had purchased
of Thomas Atkinson and containing Four hundred & Seventy
Acres and Further I lend my loving Wife during her Natural
