Amelia County on Flatt Creek being Weak of body but of Perfect  
Sound Memory thanks be to God for it and Considering the Morta-  
lity of my Body and knowing that it is Appointed for all men  
once to die do make and Ordain this my last Will & Testament  
in Manner and form following (viz) First & Principally  
Recommend my Soul to god who gave it and my body to be  
Buried in a decent Christian like Manner and as touching  
Such Worldly Estate as it hath pleased God to bless me with  
After all my just debts, paid I give divide and dispose of in -  
Manner and form Following (viz) I give and bequeath to my  
son John Bartholomew Dupree thirty Pounds Current money  
to be paid to him out of the profits of my Estate as soon as it  
can be raised, I give and bequeath to my son Peter Dupree  
one Negro Girl called Fann to him & his heirs forever  
I give and bequeath to my son James Dupree half the Tract  
of Land which I am now possessed with, I desire he may have  
it at the lower end Joining the Lands of Abraham Dierest and  
Joseph Hundley also give to my son James Dupree one Negro  
Man called Dick to him and his heirs forever, I desire that the  
two Negroes (viz) Aggo and Eve with the Increase of their bodies  
that shall be after this date may be kept in the care of my Execu-  
tors and the Profits of the said Negroes to be disposed of to my daugh-  
ter Ann Jackson as my Executors shall think proper & at the  
decease of my Daughter Ann Jackson I desire they may be Equally  
Divided between all her Children which I give to them & their heirs  
Forever, I send to my Daughter Martha Jackson one Negro boy  
called Nee and one negro girl called Jenny with the increase  
of her body that shall be after this date, which slave I desire  
she my daughter Martha Jackson and her husband may have  
the use off during their Natural lives and at their decease to  
be Equally Divided between all her Children, I give and  
Bequeath to my five grand Children (viz) Elijah Hundley  
Anthony Hundley, Charles Hundley, Ann Hundley, Elizabeth  
Hundley, the sum of Eighty pounds current money to be Equally  
Divided between them as they arrive to fairful age or Marries  
Provided that my aforesaid grand Children do acquit their

Right to a negro woman called Jane which slave is now in the  
 possession of my son James Dupree but in case any of my  
 above mentioned Grand Children should die without heir  
 of their body I desire that what I leave them may be Equally  
 Divided amongst all the survivors, I lend to my wife Judith  
 During my Stannation on which I now dwell on with half  
 the Land I hold Joining the said Plantation during her  
 Natural life and after her decease I desire it may return  
 to my Son John Bartholomew Dupree and his Heirs forever  
 I also leave my Wife Judith Dupree three Negroes (viz) Tim  
 & Joe, and Hannah during her Natural life and at her decease  
 I desire it may return as follows (viz) Negro Tom to my son  
 John Bartholomew Dupree and his Heirs forever and the  
 Other two Negroes, Joe and Hannah, I desire may be in the care  
 of my Executors for the Maintenance of my Daughter Judith  
 Dupree during her Natural life also Twenty pounds current  
 Money After her bed & Furniture a few of old all which I  
 desire may be in the care of my Executors to be disposed of by  
 them to my Daughter Judith Dupree as they shall think proper  
 during her Natural life and at her decease I desire it may  
 all be Equally Divided between all her Children lawfully  
 Begotten of her body and in case she should die without law  
 ful heir of her body I desire it may return to my three Sons  
 and their Heirs forever, I also lend to my Wife Judith Dupree  
 All my Stock and household Furniture during her Natural life  
 and after her decease my just debts and Legacies paid what is left  
 of the Stock & household Stuff I desire it may be Equally divided  
 Between all my Children also I desire that all my Negroes may  
 Continue in the care of my Executors till my Legacies are all  
 Raised, my Will further is that there be no Appraisement of my  
 Estate by Order of Court and lastly I appoint my sons John  
 Bartholomew Dupree, Peter Dupree & James Dupree my  
 Whole and Sole Executors of this my last Will, and Testament  
 hereby revoking, disannulling making Void all other Wills  
 by me made In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand  
 and Seal this twenty ninth day of June in the Year of our Lord

At a publick Sale for Amelia County the 25<sup>th</sup> day of September 1777  
This the last will and testament of Peter Dupuy Jr. and was exhibited  
to the court and proved by the oaths of two of the witnesses thereto  
subscribed and was ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of  
Peter Dupuy and James Dupuy two of the executors therein named  
who manage each ~~one~~ <sup>one</sup> in relation with Bartlett Brugh and Bartholomew  
Dupuy their jointures Junia wife and acknowledge their bond  
in the sum of \$3000 conditioned according to law, certifying  
is given this for securing the use of the said wife Junia

And it was her desire to have the 28<sup>th</sup> day of June 1778  
On the motion of Captain John Stiggy her attorney Prudent that the two executors  
of Peter Dupuy Jr. be appointed to collect with the ~~two~~ <sup>one</sup> late executors etc  
from the hands of Richard Esterton Sheriff of the County of  
Amelia and that he administer the same according to law.

Know all men by these Presents that the said Peter Dupuy & James  
Dupuy Bartlett Brugh and Bartholomew Dupuy are held and firmly  
bound to Edmund Roach Peter C. Blair & Peter Rankin and  
Thomas L. Mumford Gentlemen Justices of Court of Amelia County  
Now setting in the sum of three thousand Pounds to the payment  
Whereof, well and truly to be made to the said Justices and  
their Successors we bind ourselves, and each of us, our and each  
of our Heirs Executors, and Administrators, jointly and severally  
firmly by these presents sealed with our Seals this 25<sup>th</sup> day  
of September in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hun-  
dred and Seventy seven

The Condition of this Obligation is such that if the above  
bound Peter Dupuy and James Dupuy Executors of Peter Dupuy  
Deceased, do make or cause to be made a true and Perfect  
Inventory of all and Singular the goods, Chattels & Credits  
of the said Deceased which have or shall come to the hands  
Possession or Knowledge, of them the said Peter & James  
or into the hands and Possession of any other person or  
Persons for whom the said Peter & James and the same do exhibit  
or cause to be exhibited into the County Court of Amelia  
County at such time as to them shall be thereunto required
