Memory do make and Ordain this my last Will & Testament
in the Following Manner Viz^t. first my desire is that all
my Just Debts be paid

I Item I give and bequeath to my son John Webster one hun-
dred and Fifty Acres of land Beginning at George Powells
Corner White Oak taking in the Plantation he now lives on
making that Quantity on the Wolf Branch, also one negro
Woman Named Sarah and her increase together with the
household goods and Stocks he has now in Possession all
which I give to him and his Heirs forever

I Item I give to my son Peter Webster one hundred & fifty acres of
Land purchased of Charles Cuzzens which he now lives on also one
Negro boy Named Acce together with the household goods and Stocks
he now has in Possession all which I give to him & his heirs forever

I Item I give to my son William Webster one hundred & fifty Acres
of Land joining the land of Thomas Webster to be laid off by a straight
line from Appamattox river to a small Creek agreeable to Thomas
Webster One also one Negro boy Named Dick, with the household
goods & Stocks he now has in Possession, & one half of my Carpenters
Coopers, & Shoemakers Tools all which I give to him & his heirs forever

I Item I give to my son Anthony Webster one Negro boy Named Daniel
one Gun Called Dorton, Two Cows & Calves four Sows & Pigs together
with the household goods he has in possession, the which I give to him
and his heirs forever,

I Item I give to my son Edward Webster
the plantation whereon I now live with All my lands not heretofore
Mentioned, also three Negroes Namely, Frank, Annah, & Jim one
Bay horse Called Redhorse, one Mare Called Fancy one Mans saddle
& Two Guns one he now uses the Other Call^d Brooks Two feather
Bids and Furniture, one Folding Table made of Birch one Set
of Iron Wedges, one pine Chest, one half my Bowler, half my Carpenters
Coopers & Shoemakers Tools all my books and Wearing Clothes Two
Cows and Calves, four Sows & Pigs all my Iron pots & Pans & hoots

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All which I give to him and his heirs forever
I then I give to my Daughter Anne Vassor Two Negroes (to wit) Abram
And Jane, one Feather bed and Furniture and one Bed Chest
The remaining half of my Sewter, part of these Articles she has in
Possession all which I give to her and her heirs forever
I then I give to my Son in law George Rauborne five shilling Current
Money to be paid by my Executors

I then, I give to my Grand daughter Elizabeth Rauborne fifty pounds
Current money to be paid her when she arrive to the age of Eight-
teen years or married but if she die before either of these Occur-
rences, I desire the same be Equally Divided Among my
four Sons (to wit) John, Peter, William, and Anthony

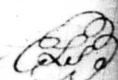
I then I Desire that my Negro Woman named Pail be sold toge-
ther with the Remainder of my estate not heretofore mention-
ed and after my Debts be discharged if any Part remain
I desire it may be Equally divided Among my four sons (to wit)
John; Peter, William, and Anthony, I desire my Estate may not
be Appraised, Lastly I constitute and Appoint my Sons
John Webster and Peter Webster Executors of this my Will, rat-
ifying and confirming this and no other to be my last Will &
Testament In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and Affixed my Seal the day & year first above Written
