 my last will and Testament disannulling all other Wills
 Whatever first and Principally I recommend my Soul into
 hands of God Who gave it me, and my body to the Earth to
 be buried in a Christian manner at the discretion of my Exors
 hereafter named, and all the worldly goods that it hath pleased
 God to bless me with I give and dispose of in manner and
 Form following

I give and bequeath to the eldest Child of Elizabeth
 Grigg Daughter of William Grigg the sum of Ten pounds to
 be paid out of my Estate by my Exors as soon as they have
 settled my Affairs, to that and its heirs forever to be applyed
 to the raising of the Child, ... I give & bequeath to my
 Brother Benjamin Abbet Graves my fully to him & his heirs forever
 I give and bequeath to my Brother William Graves, the
 remainder of my Estate both real & Personal after the settling
 of my Affairs to him & his heirs forever

I appoint, Constitute and Ordain my brother William
 Graves & my true and Trusty friend Peter Stambach to be
 My Executors of this my last Will & Testament, In Witness
 Whereof I have hereunto set my Hand & seal this tenth day
 of March .. 1776

and John Warrers are held and firmly bound to Wm. Fisher
John Calk, Com. Parker, Virion Croshing, Law Mills & Christ.
Gibson Gent Justices of the Court of Amelia County now sitting
in the sum of Five hundred Pounds Current Money to the
Payment Whereof well and Truly to be made to the said
Justices and their Successors we bind ourselves and each of
us our & each of our Heirs Executors and Administrators
jointly & severally firm by these Presents, sealed with our
Seals and dated this 22nd day of August 1776

The Condition of this Obligation is such that if the Above
Bound William Graves Executor of the last Will & Testa-
ment of Daniel Graves Decd. do make or cause to be made
What and Perfect Inventory of all & singular the goods
Chattels & Credits of the said Deceased which have or
shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of the said
William, or into the hands & possession of any other person or
Persons for him, and the same do exhibit in the
County Court of Amelia at such time as he shall be there
to required by the said Court and the same goods Chattels
& Credits of the said Deceased which at any time after shall
come to the hands possession or knowledge of the said
William or into the hands & possession of any other person
or Persons for them do well & Truly Administer according
to Law, and further do make a just & True Account of
Actings & doings therein when thereto required by the said
Court and also shall well & Truly pay and Deliver all the
Legacies Contained and specified in the said Testament
as far as the said goods Chattels & Credits will thereunto
Extend and the Law shall Charge then this Obligation to be
Void & of None Effect or Else to remain in full force & Virtue

For which I thankfully adore the divine goodness but not
knowing how soon my Change may come do make this
my last Will and Testament in manner & form Following

Elizabeth Moody Robertson my negro girl named Ann
With all her increase to them & their heirs forever and my
Will and Desire is that the said Negro should be hired
But until my Sister Martha Robertson comes of Age or
marries & then the said Negro and her Increase, & the
money with the hire to be Equally divided between
my two Sisters as above named and my Will and desire
is that if either of my two Sisters as above named should
die before they come of age or married that the other
should have the said Negro and her increase with the
hire and do hereby appoint Nathaniel Robertson
Whole sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament
In Witness Whereof I hereunto set & affix my Seal this
Twenty eighth day of September one Thousand seven hun
-dred & seventy six
