I give and bequeath all the Remaining part of my Estate
both Real and Personal to be Equally divided among all my
Children (except my Son Norvell) to them & their Heirs forever

I Appoint my Sons Norvell & Philip Dunnivant Executors
of this my Last Will & Testament In Witness Whereof I
have hereunto set my Hand and Affixed my Seal this fifteenth
