Executor of this my Last Will and Testament, and do hereby
Revoke and Make Void all former Wills by me made either
by Word of Mouth or in Writing Ratifying & Confirming
this and no other to be my last Will & Testament In WITNESS
Whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my Seal

In the Name of God Amen I Richard Dennis of the
County of Amelia & Parish of Raleigh being Sick & weak yet
of Sound and Disposing mind and Memory do think it Reasonable
To make & Ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner
and Form as Followeth

I bequeath to my Wife Dearest Dennis the Tract of Land
Whereon I now live Containing by Estimation three Acres

and Fifty Acres be the same more or less together with all the Appurtenances thereon, likewise seven Negroes their Names Bram, Brister, Farry, Kate, Jenny, Coo, & Juns. during her Natural Life, and After her Death I give the said Tract of Land Together with three Negroes & their Increase their Names, Brister, Farry, and Coo, to my son John Dennis and his Heirs forever, I give After the death of my Wife three Negroes their Names, Bram, Jenny, and Kate, to my son Henry Dennis and his Heirs Forever, I give unto my son Richard Dennis After the Death of my Wife my Negro Woman Juns to him and his Heirs Forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my son Henry Dennis one Hundred and Forty Acres of land be the same more or less Lying and being in the County of Amelia joining the lands of Samuel Vaughan, on the North, and Peter Randolph Bland on the South likewise Ten Negroes their Names York, Fenny, Aggy, Windsor, Ned, Sucky, Jemmy, Lucy, Mitty and Lucie, also a feather bed & Furniture, to him & his Heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my son Richard Dennis seven Negroes their Names, James, Food, Pheby, young Brister, young York, Belly and Call, also a feather bed & Furniture to him and his Heirs Forever.

Item I give to be Equally Divided between my two Sons - Henry and Richard Dennis, a Tract of four Hundred Acres of Land in the County of Lunenburg and granted to me by Patent bearing date the Twelfth day of May one thousand Seven hundred and Seventy to them & their Heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my son John Dennis two Tracts of Land in the County of Lunenburg which Lands I Purchased of Phelimon Ruspel and containing (in one Tract by Estimation two hundred and Twenty Eight Acres be the same more or less, and the Other Tract one Hundred & Seventy eight as per Patent sheweth, likewise six Negroes their Names Robin, Peter, Dick, Nan, Mfey and Clarissa also my Colt Janna.. two Work Steers known by the Names of Lion and Pantor. Six Cows & six Calves two Feather beds & Furniture a walnut

Desk, a Walnut Table and a case of Bottles to him and
His Heirs Forever

I Tem I leave to my three sons Henry, Richard & John
Dennis to be Equal sharers (after my Wifes Death) In
a copper Still

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary Pryor
one Hundred & fifty acres of Land lying on Cellar Creek
In Amelia County and bounded as Followeth) Beginning
at the North Corner on the Cellar Creek thence West Twenty one
Degrees North one Hundred and Seventy Poles on short line
to his Corner, thence North Seventeen & a half Degrees East
one Hundred and Twenty six Poles to a corner thence East
Five Degrees, South one Hundred and fifty eight Poles to
a corner on the Cellar Creek, thence up the Meanders of the
Said Creek to the Beginning likewise a Feather Bed and
Furniture, one Cow & Calf and a Walnut Chest of Drawers
To her and Her Heirs forever

Item I lend to my Daughter Elizabeth Pincham three Negroes
their Names Suchy, Anthony, and Billy a feather bed and
Furniture and large leather Trunk During her Natural
Life and after her Death to be Equally divided between
all her Children that she leaves alive (Except her son Rich.
Dennis Pincham, whom I direct to have no part in the said
Slaves to them and their Heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to my Grandson Richard Dennis
Pincham an negro girl named beck, to him & his heirs forever
Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Dennis
Eight Negroes their Names, Jenny, Grace, Lucy, Cynthia, Fanny,
Lewis, Phillis, and Jimmy, likewise a young bay Mare known
by the Name of Polly Regulars, a chest of drawers, a small Walnut
Inlaid Table, Two Feather beds & Furniture and a looking
Glass to her and her Heirs forever

Item I give to my Son John my old bay Mare also two sows
and Pigs

Item I give and bequeath my Flock of Sheep after my Wifes
Death to be Equally Divided Between my son John Dennis

And my Daughters Sarah Dennis
 Item I lend all the Remaining Part of ~~Part~~ of my Estate not
 heretofore Mentioned or Willed away of all Kinds whatsoever
 to my Wife Dearest Dennis during her Natural life it is
 also my Will that my wife Pay all my Just Debts out of the
 Legacies left her by this my last Will & Testament and if
 my Crop of tobacco & Wheat be not Sufficient (together with
 the Debts due to my Estate) for the Faithful discharge ^{such of} of Just
 Debts, Then I leave her full Power and Authority, If she find it
 convenient, to sell any Part of the Legacies left her) Land
 and Negroes Excepted for the Payment of the said Debts
 and in this Case a bill from her shall be good to any
 Purchaser and after Death it is my Will & desire that all
 the remaining Part or Parts of the Legacies left her be Equally
 Divided amongst my five Children (To Wit) Henry, Richard
 John, Elizabeth & Sarah, it is my Desire that my Estate
 be not Appraised, and lastly I do Constitute and Appoint
 my three Sons Henry, Richard and John Dennis whole
 and sole Executors to this my last Will and Testament
 Hereby Revoking and Disannulling all other Wills by me
 heretofore made In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set
 my Hand and seal this third day of May Anno Domini ..
 one thousand Seven hundred & Seventy five
