 manner and form following, to wit, my Will is that my
 Estate Real and Personall shall remain in my Executors
 hands during the minority of my son Joseph to enable
 them to discharge my Just Debts & to maintain my
 Wife and Children also to educate and bring up my
 Children my Will is that my Executors may at any time
 sell any part of my Personall Estate and lay out the
 Money arising from such Sales as also the profits of
 my Estate in purchasing Slaves if they shall think it to
 be advantageous to my Estate I will that my Wife shall
 during her Widowhood live in the house I now live in
 and shall have a plain gentle maintainance during her
 said Widowhood and if she should Marry I then give
 her Ten Pounds p^r Year during her natural life all
 which I give her in full compensation of her Right of
 Dower I give to my son John all that tract of land
