 it into the Number of blessed Spirits, who enjoy his presence. His
 Chappin Immence Eternity and for my frail & Mortal body full
 of Sins & Imperfections I desire may be committed to the Earth out
 of which it was formed without pomp or needless expence, with
 a firm Assurance that my Redeemer liveth & will at the last
 day appear incircled with Angels & with Angels I raise us from
 the dead with bodies raised from the trage of Mortality, I as to my Temporal
 Estate which the Almighty has been graciously pleased to bestow upon
 me, I give and dispose of in Manner following, I will that the
 Land whereon I now live, be sold for the best Price that can be got
 by my Executors, hereafter Named, & after my just debts are paid
 that out of the money arising from the sale of my Land, Reps
 and Other moneys due to me, my Executors purchase a Tract of land
 and Plantation, which Plantation I lend my Loving Wife Ann
 during her Natural life, she committing no waist thereon. I also lend
 my wife all the rest of my Estate of what kind soever, untill my
 Children come of Age or marry, the better to Enable her to Educate
 and bring them up, which I desire she may do in the best manner
 my Estate will Afford, but should my Wife neglect so to do, I desire
 my Executors will take it upon themselves, I pay the Expence out of
 the Profits of my Estate, and my Will is that as my Children comes of
 Age or marry that there be an Equal division of all my Estate, except
 the Land, & Delivered to each Child so married or come of Age their
 Equal share or Dividend reserving to my Loving wife a Childs part
 and after the death of my wife, my desire is that the Land be sold &
 the money arising therefrom with all other of my Estate then remaining

be Equally divided among my Children; further my Will and
Desire is that in case any of my Children die before they arrive
to the Age of twenty one Years, or Marries, that there part so
dying, be Equally Divided among the Survivors of them; & Should
my Executors think it Convenient to Sell any of my Slaves on Account
