I give and bequeath to my son Abraham Howell the sum of thirty five pounds of the like currency, being Abond upon the said John Howell . . . I give and bequeath to my wife Sarah Howell the remaining part of my Estate to be profest by her During her Natural Life or Widownhood After which is my Will that the whole of my Estate be Equally Divided Among all my Children named as follows Charles Howell John Howell, Susanna Howell, Sarah Howell, Lucretia Howell, Spicer Howell, Bettie Howell, Nanny Howell, Molly Howell, Lucretia Howell, Stephen Howell, & Abram Howell I Conste and Appoint my wife Sarah Howell, my Sons John & Spencer Howell Executors of this my Last Will & Testament & I do hereby utterly Disallow, revoke & disannul all & every other former Will or Wills Legacies & bequeathes ratifying and Confirming this & no other to be my Last Will & Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal the day & year above written
