Thomas Bolling Munford of Amelia County being extremely  
sick and weak in body tho. of sound mind & memory desired by  
God for it do constitute and Appoint this my last Will and Testament  
in Manner and form following that is to say I bequeath my Soul to  
God who gave it and my body to the Earth from whence it was taken  
to be decently buried in sum and certain expectation of its  
at the last day, and with respect to my worldly Goods with which  
it hath pleased God to bless me; After my just debts & Funeral  
Expences are paid, give and bequeath as follows  
I am desirous bequeath unto my loving Wife Jane Munford four hun-  
dred Acres of land, including the buildings on my Mannour plantation  
known by the name of Bollingbrook, likewise a single Chair together with  
all my Stock and household Furniture, Except a team of horses such as  
my Executors think can best be spared, I leave to be sold with my  
Waggon, the use of the S<sup>t</sup>. Stock & Furniture I leave my said loving  
Wife until my Children come of Age when each of them shall draw  
their proportion of laid Stock & Furniture, reserving to my said Wife  
one equal part of S<sup>t</sup>. Stock & Furniture with the land above mentioned  
during her Widewhood; Likewise give and bequeath unto my said  
Wife Jane Munford during her Natural life the following Slaves viz  
Pinch, Rochester, Jo Ellick, Anna, Juda, & Old Shiloh, and after her  
death the S<sup>t</sup>. Slaves with their increase, I leave to be Equally divided  
Among my surviving Children, all the rest of my Slaves I leave to be  
Equally divided among my Children by lot at the discretion of my Executors  
as they separately come of Age, likewise all my Lands I leave to be  
equally divided in the same manner by lot as they come of Age  
all which S<sup>t</sup>. legacies I give and bequeath to my S<sup>t</sup>. Children & their  
heirs forever together with all the rest & residue of my Estate not

before draftit and further my Will and desire is that there be no  
Appraisement of my Estate

And hereby Appoint my Brother Edward Mumford my Worthy  
Friends Richard Jones, Samuel Atherwin, Nathan Fletcher and  
Samuel Davis Executors of this my last Will and Testament On  
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 24 day  
of April in the Year of our Lord 1780.

In the Name of God Amen I James Daper of the Parish of Haverhill  
and County of Angtler being in perfect sense and Memory but calling to  
mind the Mortality of Man, that it is appointed for all men once to  
die do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament disannulling  
all other Wills whatsoever and first and principally I give and bequeath  
my Soul into the hands of God who gave it me and my body to the earth  
to be buried in Christian manner at the discretion of my Executors here  
after named and all my Worldly Goods I give & dispose of in manner  
and form following, I promise & send to my beloved wife Sarah  
Daper one hundred Acres of land including the plantation whereon  
I now live, and my Negro Wench Nan, and Child named John also  
one feather Bed and Furniture, also a Childs part of the household  
and kitchen Furniture, also six head of cattle & a childs part of  
sheep & hogs and one Mare & Saddle during her Natural life or  
Widowhood; I give and bequeath to my Son William Daper  
Fifty Acres of land being the land whereon he now lives, also my
