their proportion of said Stock & Furniture, reserving to my said Wife
one equal part of S. Stock & Furniture with the land above mentioned
during her Widowhood; Likewise give and bequath unto my said
Wife Jane Munford during her Natural life the following Slaves viz
Punch, Rochester, Jo Ellick, Annaca, Juda, & Old Phillis, and after her
death the S. Slaves with their Increase, I leave to be Equally divided
Among my Surviving Children, all the rest of my Slaves I leave to be
Equally divided among my Children by lot at the discretion of my Executors
