Land in Chesterfield County Containing Fifty acres more or less
Which I bought of Grizzell to him & his heirs forever.

Item I give to my Nephew Thomas Draper, after my Decease,
my Negro Fellow Ned to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give to my Nephew Thomas Draper all the remainder
of my Estate both real & Personal at my decease to him and
his Heirs forever.

Lastly I Nominate Constitute & Appoint my Nephew & Godson
Thomas Draper whole & sole Executor both real & personal of this
my last Will & Testament. In Witness I do hereby set my
hand and Seal this 26th day of February . . . 1777
