Annah with her increase to her and her Heirs forever

Item I give to my Grand Daughter Elizabeth Layne one Negro
Boy Named Will which I give to her and her Heirs forever

Item I give to my Daughter Annitta Caldwell one Negro Named
Archer to her and her Heirs forever

I also give my said daughter Annitta one Cow & calf who has
already in Possession

Lastly I constitute & Appoint my son Frederick Reams Executor
