In the name of God Amen I William Jackson of
the County of Amelia the first day of November one thousand Seven
hundred & Seventy Eight, being of Perfect sense & memory, therefore let
ling to mind the Mortality of my body, knowing that it is Appointed
to all men once to die do make & Ordain this my last Will and
Testament, That is to say, First & Principally of all I give & recommend
my soul into the hands of God that gave it, & my body I recommend to
the Earth to be Inter'd In a decent & Christian Interment at the
Discretion of my Executors, and As Touching such Worldly Estates
where with it hath pleased God to bestow on me in this life, I Give
Demise & dispose of in the following Manner & form:
Imprimis, I give & devise to my Daughter Mary Burham & her heirs
one hundred Acres of Land by a Deed Acknowledg'd in Court, among
only she must pay fifty pounds to her Sister Patty Clemons & keep
the negro boy Peter having given her before this Considerable for her
portion, Then I give & devise to my Son W:m Jackson one Negro
man named Cesar, after my wife deceased & not before taking his

I now give & Devise to my Daughter Susanna Jackson, one Negro
boy Named Sam, to her & her Heirs forever
Item I give & devise to my Son Daniel Jackson, one Negroman
Named Jack, after my wifes decease & not before
Item I give & devise to my Son Isaac Jackson, the remainder of my
Land, after my Decease & my wifes, it being the house & the Improvements
With the Orchard & one negro woman Named Dinah after my
Wifes Decease, & not before to him & his Heirs forever
Item I give and devise to my Daughter Susanna Quarles, one
Negro boy Named Jupiter, to her & her Heirs &c
Item I give & Devise to my Daughter Patty Clement fifty pounds
From her Sister Durham, being Part of the Value of the boy -
Peter, and Thirty pounds ^{Cash} out of my Estate more, being in the whole
Eighty Pounds to her & her Heirs forever
Item I give & Devise to my Youngest Daughter Priscilla Jackson
One negro Girl named Eve, & her Increase, one Featherbed and
Furniture to her & her Heirs forever
Item I send to my beloved Wife Susanna Jackson, During her
Natural Life, my house & Plantation whereon I now live, &
the use of three Negroes, Viz. Ceazar, Jack, & Dinah, & all the
Remainder part of my Estate Not already given, with my Stock
of all kinds & my Plantation Utencils, & after her decease, what
Part of my Estate ^{that} shall remain for all my just Debts to be paid,
and then, the residue be Equally Divided between my Son Isaac
Jackson & my Daughter Priscilla Jackson

Item I last of all Constitute and Appoint John Manire & my
Son Daniel Jackson to be my Executors of this my Last Will &
Testament revoking all former Wills by me made, Witness
my hand & Seal the day of year above written
