divided between her Children, She and her Increase to them & their Heirs
Forever, I also give to my daughter Ann Evans Neal, one Negro
Boy named Kitt, and one Negro Girl named Milly, one young mare
named Monday, one Feather Bed and Furniture two Cows and calves & a
Heifer, a half dozen of Pewter plates, two dishes & two Basins
I also give to my Grandson Joel Neal & Anne a negro wench named Pat.
she and her Increase forever, if he lives to have a child, & if not she is
to come back into my Estate. I also give to my son John Neal
all my Land, as far as got by Old Salim to him & his Heirs forever,
And the rest of my Estate I lend to my wife Ann Neal during her life and at
her death to be Equally divided between all my Children that is alive now,
I also desire that my wife should have the use of the plantation whereon I
now live for her life, I Appoint make and Ordain this my last Will &
Testament Appointing my wife Ann Neal and Miles Bott Executors
of this my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and affixed my Seal this twenty second day of June in the
Year of Our Lord Christ one thousand Seven hundred & Seventy eight
