make this my last Will and Testament as follows Viz
I Give and bequeath to my beloved Wife Martha Dyson
two Feather Beds and furniture there belonging to her and
her heirs for ever as likewise one Negro Boy named George
during her life and at her decease to descend to John
Dyson son of my Brother William Dyson, I Give also
one Negro Wench named Lucy to my Wife Martha
Dyson during her life and at her decease to my sister
Rachel Gills son Archer Gills, I give also my one third of
my Land left me by Father to my Wife during her life
and at her decease to my Brother Daniel Dyson for ever
I also give my one third of my house hold and kitchen fur-
niture to my Wife during her life and at her decease to
descend to my sister Elizabeth Dyson Wife of Drury Daniel
I Give also all debts due to me to my Wife to dispose of as
she shall think proper, I Leave also my Wife Executors
with Zachariah Burthright and William Dyson Executors
to this my Last Will and Testament to see all things
properly settled as Witnesses my hand and seal this 16th
Day of November 1782
