my son Benjamin Lipscomb one Shilling
Item I give & bequeath unto my son Thomas Lips-
comb one Shilling - Item I give & bequeath unto
my son Parrabal Lipscomb one Shilling
Item I give & bequeath unto my son Richard Lipscomb
one Shilling Item I give & bequeath unto my Daughter

And I give one Shilling & Sixpence to
my Daughter Elmina Lescumb two Negro Girls
named Jesse & Eve with their Increase also one Bed
& Furniture (a Powder Book & six Powder Plates by
her freely to be possessed & enjoyed

Item I give to my son Brian Lescumb whom I
likewise constitute make & ordain the sole Executor
of this my last will & Testament Eight Negroes
to wit; Hannah, Laphre, Linder, Leante, Avey, Sam
Rachel, & Jerry, with their Increase, also my stock
of every kind, household furniture, & plantation
utensils by him freely to be possessed & enjoyed, I do
hereby utterly revoke & disannul all former Wills and
Testaments by me heretofore made, ratifying and
confirming this & no other to be my last will & Testament
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal
this seventeenth day of July in the year of our Lord one
thousand seven hundred & seventy eight
