Land and plantation whereon I now live also three negroes Viz. Lucy, Pat
and Prince during her life also all my Stock of cattle, sheep, hogs & horses
& all my household & kitchen Furniture, and Plantation utensels during
her life and after her decease as it is named in the Will as followeth.

I Give unto my son Tho^s. Westbrook one negro wench Lucy & her increase
after the date of this my Will after my wifes decease to him & his heirs forever.

I Give unto my son James Westbrook one negro girl Fanny & her increase
to him & his heirs forever.

I Give unto my son Henry Westbrook his
Part of Land as it was laid off to him & his heirs forever, also I lend unto
son Henry Westbrook during his life one negro boy Prince and after his decease
I give the same to his son Tho^s. Westbrook and his heirs forever.

I Give I lend unto my daughter Edy Byassee during her life one negro girl
Bott and her increase and after her decease I give the same to be equally di-
vided among her Children.

I Give I lend unto my daughter Susanna Mills one
Negro girl Pat and her increase during her life, and after her decease I give
the s^d. Pat and her increase to be equally divided among her Children.

I Give I lend unto my son Charles Westbrook after my wifes decease the Land
and Plantation whereon I now live from the ridge path to Fryors line to Cedar
Creek up the Creek to Blands line from thence to the ridge Path & after his decease

I give the Land & Plantation to his son Henry Westbrook & his heirs forever
also I lend unto my son Charles Westbrook one negro boy Bob during his life
& after his decease I give the s^d. negro Bob to his son Henry Westbrook & his heirs
forever.

I Give unto my two Grand sons Charles Byassee & Charles
Mills after my decease all the Land from the ridge path & Henry Westbrooks
line & the Cedar Creek to Fryors & from thence to the ridge Path to be
equally divided between them & their heirs forever - also it is my desire
that after my wifes decease that all my personal estate that has not been

Children I do also appoint my two sons Tho^s Westbrook & James West-
brook Executors of this my Last Will and Testament In Witness where-
