This Inventory and appraisment of the estate of Matthew Hillsman dec^d. was returned into Court with the report of the Commissioners hereto annexed and was ordered to be recorded

Daniel Jackson of the County of Andros being at Present times of Sound Perfect mind & memory Thanks be to the Almighty God for it; but calling to mind that it is Appointed for all men once to die, do make & ordain this to be my Last Will & Testament and first of all I give & recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God, that gave it, & my body to the Earth to be buried in

A Christian manner at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named
and as for my worldly estate which God hath given me I give devise
and dispose of, as in form & manner following

Imprimis I give and devise unto my son George Jackson and to his heirs
forever one hundred & fifty acres of land - Item I give & devise unto
my son W.^r Jackson and to his heirs forever the remainder of my land
being one hundred & fifty Acres - Item I give and devise to my daugh-
-ter Susanah Worsham Jackson & to her heirs forever one Negro Girl
named Jane & her increase &c., Then my will & desire is, that if my wife
is deliver'd of a son to have anegro boy nam'd a look, and if a daughter
to have the above mention'd negro boy Allick to him or her forever &c.
Item I leave to my well beloved wife Ann Jackson during her Natural
Life one Negro wench named Esther & one negro boy named Pimby &
Stocks of all kinds with the house hold Furniture &c.

Item Last of all do I ordain constitute & Appoint my well beloved friends
Joshua Durham & Stephen Clement to be my whole & sole Executors of this
my last Will and Testament In Witnes whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and Seal this 29th day of January 1781

- it is my desire my Estate be not appraised
