I give Devise, and Bequeath all the remaining part or
parts of my Estate of every kind whatsoever to my Son
Rich Dennis to him and his Heirs forever & I nominate
constitute and appoint him the said Rich Dennis
Executor of this my last Will and Testament which
I sign Seal publish and Deliver the 21st day of
April 1780.
