to be equally divided among my Children & Grand Children  
in the same proportion and in the same manner, as the other  
part of my estate is directed to be divided in the former part  
of this my Will - Item it is my Will that at the division  
of my Estate my negroes be Appraised and that my son in  
Law John Bell receive from my other Legatees part his  
equal proportion of their Value, but I desire he may have  
none of the negroes & Lastly I appoint my son Isaac  
Hill & my Neighbour Christopher Ford Exec<sup>rs</sup> of this my  
Will revoking the Executorship of my son Joel Witness  
my hand & Seal the 15<sup>th</sup> Sep<sup>r</sup> 1779

In the Name of God Amen this twenty third day of Jan<sup>y</sup>  
one thousand Seven hundred & Eighty one, I Edward Dudley of the County  
of Amelia being Sick and Weak but of Perfect Sense and Memory do make  
and Ordain this as my Last Will & Testament in manner & form following  
Inprimis Give and bequeath to my Son James Dudley the tract of Land that  
I purchased of Leonard Claiborne sen<sup>r</sup> containing by Estimation one hundred  
and thirty two Acres and likewise twenty acres of Land to be taken off of  
the Lower part of the Land that I now live on that I purchased of Roger  
Pearse, so running the line that the back land be as wide as at the Creek to him

And his heirs & assigns forever

Now I give & bequeath to my son John Dudley the Remainder of the land that I now live on that I purchased of Joseph Kirkland, Roger Ames & and John Trapp the said Priors lying in Dimittie to him & his heirs - and Assigns forever, - I now give and bequeath to my daughter Lucy Lewis a Negro Woman Named Judy that she hath now in possession to her and her heirs forever, - I now give & bequeath to my daughter Ann Affriend a Negro man named Daniel that she hath now in possession to her & her heirs forever

I now give and bequeath to each of my other Children James Dudley John Dudley & Sally Dudley a negro out of my Estate equal in Value to that that I have given to my daughter Ann Affriend to him & her heirs forever, - Now my Will & desire is that the Remainder of my Estate be kept together until my son John Dudley arrive to the age of twenty one years & worked upon my Land & that my said son John Dudley and my daughter Sally Dudley be maintained out of the profits arising from the said Estate at the discretion of my Executors, and when my said son John Dudley is of the age of twenty one years then the s<sup>d</sup> Remainder of my Estate be Equally divided between my daughter Lucy Lewis my daughter Ann Affriend my son James Dudley, my son John Dudley my daughter Sally Dudley and my Grandson Leonard Chubborne, saving that my daughter Lucy Lewis have out of the s<sup>d</sup> remainder of my Estate as much as will make the Negro I gave her equal to that that I gave to my daughter Ann Affriend before the said Estate be divided. - lastly I hereby constitute & Ordain my friend Sam<sup>l</sup> Wills my son James Dudley & my son in law Benj<sup>m</sup> Affriend Executors of this my last Will and Testament, revoking and disannulling all former Wills by me made confirming this as my only & last Will & Testament -  
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the day & year first above Written
